

**Here are the results for the October 10<sup>th</sup> 2009 Pine Barons R/C club FALL-FUN FLY** - Written and run by Eric Henderson.

There were 17 contestants who braved the somewhat wet conditions. Most flew when there was no rain, but the hardy few kept on flying even when it rained. Nothing would dampen their sprits. We pushed hard to get it all done in the morning because high crosswinds were forecast (accurately by the way), in the afternoon. The first two events were designed as skill tests and the last event included a randomizing factor to allow anyone to win!

**PERSONAL TIMED FLIGHT** - Before the pilots took off they stated their intended flight time as a number anywhere between 30 and 90 seconds. The results were quite amazing with some very close and accurate guesses.

The results were: 1<sup>st</sup> Bob Tucker - 0 (zero) seconds difference from his guess, 2<sup>nd</sup> Fred Perkins - 1 second, 3<sup>rd</sup> Bob Fort - 5 seconds under, 4<sup>th</sup> Ed Milburn - 5 seconds over, 5<sup>th</sup> Doug Milke - 7 seconds, 6<sup>th</sup> T. J. Emanuel - 11 seconds, 7<sup>th</sup> Ken Flaer - 13 Seconds, and 8<sup>th</sup> Harry Minnier - 15 seconds. 1<sup>st</sup> prize was a Multiplex TWINSTAR.



**SPOT-LANDING** - I brought a tape measure to see who would be closest to the spot. I only had to use it once! The rest of the time I measured the distance in "PACES!" In their defense it was a bit wet and windy and they did make the runway, which has not always been the case in the past! Fun was had trying to stick the landing and more fun picking up the bits 😊
