We have all had problems at the field that ended up with a plane crashing. Crashing out in the field is not a major issue however; it could cause issues for the farmer if we trample his crops. If you crash out there please be cautious on how you go on a search and rescue mission. First idea is see if somebody has a drone and can search for the downed aircraft. When walking in the field try and do your best to stay in the rows between crops or at least minimize any potential damage.

Now for another circumstance- if you crash into the owners building the proper procedure is- 1) Ask the owner for permission to go on to his building before doing so. 2) Notify the club officers of any damage. 3) If you have done damage it is your responsibility to have a properly insured contractor do the repairs. 4) Notify your homeowners and the AMA insurance if you feel that you can not handle the cost of repairs. 5) Keep your club officers advised as to everything that transpires.
